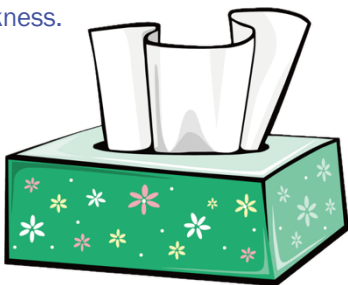
Printing at School

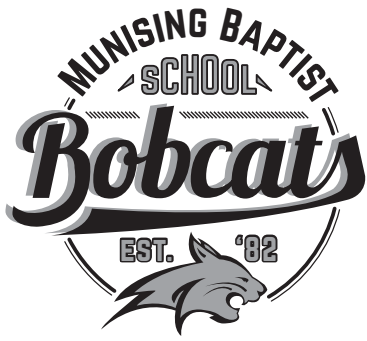
